

Dear Members,

A number of registered clubs on the Northern Beaches have taken the decision to continue the mandatory COVID-19 vaccination policy for staff and patrons currently in place until 15 December 2021, till at least 31 January 2022.

All staff, members, guests and contractors will continue to show proof they are fully vaccinated, or have a medical exemption, before they are allowed entry.

The ongoing health and safety of our staff, patrons and the wider community is our highest priority.

Considering the vaccination rate of the Northern Beaches is 94%, it is obvious our community has embraced the vaccination with enthusiasm and we firmly believe this proactive step will be appreciated by the overwhelming majority. We are all mindful of current NSW Health Orders and the stance taken by other national businesses such as QANTAS, Virgin Airlines and Coles.

Clubs will review this decision on 31 January 2022, or if COVID circumstances change in the meantime.
